Unit 2 HTML Basics

For the next few assignments you will be creating Help pages for one of your Programming Logic – Intermediate programs (Assignment Tracker, DVD database, etc). If you no longer have the program, ask me—I probably still have a copy.

Use the following Help system as an example:

Alternate: If you have a web site that you'd like to develop for an organization or yourself, check with me to see if the site could meet my requirements. If the site needs a database, save it for Web Data Management.

This first portion of the assignment will demonstrate your basic HTML skills. **No formatting is required** (styles) but you may add formatting if you wish. You may have to replace in the Unit 3 assignment.

This must include the following to must demonstrate the following HTML competencies:

- ☐ Since this is the primary page of your web site, be sure to give it the appropriate name.
- ☐ A folder to hold the page and images used on the page.
- ☐ All components of the <head> tag designated in class
- ☐ One comment
- ☐ Headings
- ☐ Two paragraphs describing how to use features on the page.
(After the Unit 5 assignment, your web site must include complete documentation so consider adding more than two paragraphs now)
- ☐ Line break
- ☐ One bold element
- ☐ One italics element
- ☐ One element that is both bold and italics
- ☐ Image
 - ☐ For all images, include a height and width designation that matches the actual size of the image
- ☐ Horizontal rule
- ☐ Unordered list
- ☐ Ordered list
- ☐ Special character other than a non-breaking space
- ☐ Special character from <http://www.chami.com/tips/internet/050798I.html> that is not included in the course notes

You may add the words *at least* to all the bullets above. You may include more components in your web page, but you must incorporate them correctly. Your web page must validate using the W3C HTML5 Validator.
