## Unit 3 - CSS

Enhance the web page you created for the Unit 2 – HTML Basics assignment, formatting the page using CSS.

You must demonstrate the following CSS competencies:

- ☐ CSS external files stored in a separate CSS folder.
- ☐ An external style sheet that controls the format of at least 3 elements
- ☐ An embedded style sheet (<style> tag) that controls the format of at least 1 element
- ☐ At least one inline style

All of the following may be implemented using external, internal or inline styles.

- ☐ Define one style that is applied to a tag (e.g. <p> <h1>)
- ☐ Define and apply one named style (e.g. .sample)
- ☐ Define and apply one ID style
- ☐ Alignment change
- ☐ Image centered horizontally on the page
- ☐ Horizontal line (with a customized color, width/height)
- ☐ Unordered list that uses an image as a bullet
- ☐ Change the text color of at least one element
- ☐ Change the background color of at least one element
- ☐ Use at least one named color
- ☐ Use at least one RGB color combination
- ☐ Use at least one hexadecimal color designation
- ☐ Change the font of at least one element
- ☐ For each font you designate, also designate the font **family** the browser should use if the first font is not available.
- ☐ Change the font size of at least one element using an absolute font size.
- ☐ Change the font size of at least one element using a relative font size
- ☐ Change the kerning and/or tracking of at least one element
- ☐ Change the first line indent of at least one paragraph
- ☐ Using a style (not <i> or <em>), change one element of your web site to display italics
- ☐ Using a style (not <b> or <strong>), change one element of your web site to bold face
- ☐ Using a style (not <u>), change one element of your web site to underlined
- ☐ Using a style (not a special character), include at least one superscripted or subscripted item in your web site.
- ☐ Use at least one <span> tag in your web site.

- ☐ Include at least one image in your site that demonstrates text wrapping around it.
- ☐ Change the margins of an image that has text wrapped around it.
  
- ☐ Add a background image to the page, but only have the image tile vertically (up and down).
- ☐ Change the image tag so the background image doesn't scroll when the page does.
- ☐ Change the margins of that web page so the background image doesn't appear behind the text

**Extra Credit (2 points)**

- ☐ (½ point) Apply a blurred text shadow to at least one element.
- ☐ (½ point) Apply a transform to rotate text
- ☐ (1 point) Apply a transition to one of your images that enlarges the image after the user hovers over it for 2 seconds
